

Brooklyn born, Prof. Dovid Katz is an international authority on Yiddish and Ashkenazic Jewish culture. He founded Yiddish studies at Oxford University, where he taught for 18 years, and then in Vilnius, where he was professor of Yiddish there for 11 years. He has published many academic works in Yiddish studies in addition to three collections of original, award-winning Yiddish fiction. He lectures throughout the world at prominent academic and research institutions. He is also a leader of the movement against Holocaust revisionism in Eastern Europe.
