- 10:00 Unveiling ceremony for the commemorative plaques in front of the Metropolis Hotel, Daukanto str. 21, Kaunas.

- 11:00 Unveiling ceremony for the commemorative plaques at the platform as well as, announcement of the release of a commemorative envelope and stamp dedicated to Mr. Chiune Sugihara and Mr. Jan Zwartendijk to mark the 75th anniversary of ‘Visas for Life,’ at the Kaunas Railway Station, M.K.
