Cbai Basi (daughter of I Budgor) was sister of Menucha, house #15. Szloyme was an expert horse trailer. Bu horses from the farmers and sell them in bigger towns. Just before 1939, Mr. Baron from Oshmania, came with a German businessman to buy horses from us.
